
Sogang Service Learning Program

Students will have the opportunity to participate in community service with Korean and international students.





Program Description:


Two-credit service learning course consisting of 7-8 classroom sessions (lecture, discussion, student presentations, etc.) and at least 30 hours of community service during the academic semester.

Course Objectives:

- To learn the communication skills necessary for community service.
- To understand the characteristics and needs of different groups (children, teenagers, the disabled, etc.)
- To participate in at least 30 hours of community service.
- To synthesize what was learned in the classroom and what was experienced during volunteer work.
- To gain a respect for others and an appreciation of the value of serving the community.

Course Details:

- Attendance is mandatory, and students must receive certification of at least 30 hours of volunteer work.
- · The course grade will be given as 'pass or fail' only.
- International students will be placed with Korean students in the course with course materials, discussions and student presentations offered in English. International students will work in small groups with Korean students.
- · International student enrollment will be limited to 15 students.
- Volunteer placements will be assigned in the class.



Eligibility:

- Undergraduate exchange students to Sogang University.
- Students who are recommended by the home institution.
- Students who will successfully complete the course.

Registration:

• Students can register for the course during the regular course registration period through the online portal registration system.
